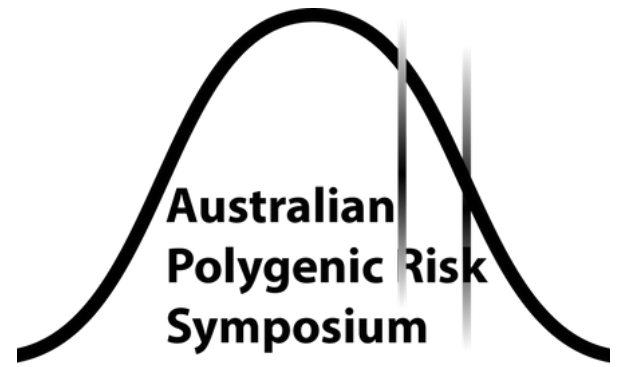

20-22 April 2021



The second **Australian Polygenic Risk Symposium** will be a 'virtual' meeting across three days from **20-22 April 2021**. It will bring together researchers, clinicians, educators and industry to focus on the applications of polygenic risk and its clinical implementation.

The objectives of the Symposium are to advance research into the clinical applications of polygenic risk and its implementation by:

- Bringing together multidisciplinary experts in the field;
- Updating attendees on current research and practice in polygenic risk;
- Planning a national approach to research polygenic risk information from discovery through to clinical translation; and
- Identifying gaps in the field and future research directions

The program will feature a mix of talks, panels and workshops from invited international and Australasian speakers, as well as submitted oral presentations, providing a valuable opportunity for authors to present their work.

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
